## Who may participate?

The offer is addressed to 280 Hamburg primary school children attending the third grade or VK 3/4 (preparatory class), with or without a migration background. They should be particularly considered as children who need support to improve their language skills.

How to apply for participation?

School is responsible for the application. Talk to the class teacher of your child. You will receive an application form which you return filled in to the teacher. You may also work on the form together with your

child's teacher. The teacher, too, will fill in an application form. Both forms will be sent to Jugenderholungswerk Hamburg e.V. by school. Your application should be there by the end of march, please!

You will then receive by mail an invitation for a date of

registration in the office of Jugenderholungswerk or at school. The official registration formalities will then be done, details of the trip will be discussed, any open questions will be resolved. Finally the parental contribution of  $\in$  62.50 is to be paid.
